High School NOMINATION FORM



To be awarded to a junior or senior secondary World Languages student who exhibits superior performance in the World Languages class. The nominating teacher must be a current FLAM member.

The nominated student must:

- *Demonstrate superior ability dependent upon student level of study (novice, intermediate or advanced) in reading and listening comprehension, interpersonal and presentational speaking/writing and cultural awareness.*
- *Demonstrate excellence in classroom cooperation and good citizenship.*
- *Exemplify respect and responsibility towards the learning of a world language.*
- *Display leadership and trustworthiness in the classroom.*
- Request **two additional letters of recommendation** from teachers, club sponsors, or coaches other than the teacher who nominated you. At least one of the recommendations needs to be from a teacher.
- Complete the **essay questions** and provide them to the nominating teacher.

The nominating teacher must:

- Provide the student with the student essay form
- Submit **this nomination form**
- Submit the **student essay responses**
- Submit **two (2) additional letters of recommendation** on behalf the student
